Career opportunities after the BCE include: secondary teaching, adult education, journalism, tourism, working for the media or in public history, among others.

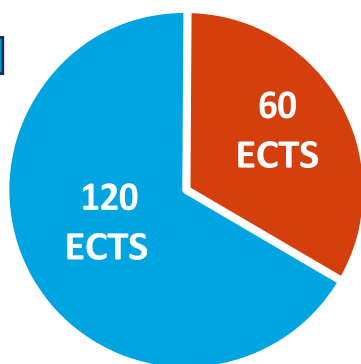
