RESEARCH PROJECT

I am studying the interaction of climate change and economic insecurity, examining both looking at the consequences of being exposed to extreme weather events, and the efficiency of existing policies to mitigate insecurity. I apply quasi-experimental methods at the micro level using longitudinal survey data. The first paper of my dissertation explores the effects of exposure to Cyclone Ana on objective and subjective economic insecurity in Malawi.
