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1. Methodology

1.1. Characteristics of graduates

The MSc in Finance and Economics – Banking track 13 graduates in 2022.

1.2. <u>Investigation protocol</u>

At this stage, the University/Faculty do not have a deep employability survey for each Master programmes and tracks. The data of this survey have been collected with the help of the Alumni Office of the University. No questionnaire has been sent to the graduates. The data are coming from the LinkedIn social network. Each individual will be called "respondents"

The survey looks at the situation of graduates in the November 7th, i.e., 2 months after the examination board.


1.3. Characteristics of respondents

1.3.2. EU and non-EU repartition


The respondents are mainly EU-European (or EU citizens) (80%).


80 % of the respondents indicated in their profile that they are employed. 10% (1) is declared as intern (profile not updated). 10% (1) is currently unemployed.

2.2. Repartition between the public and private sector among employed

2.3. Geographic distribution



Among the 10 respondents declared as employed, 80% are working in Luxembourg and 10% in Italy.

2.4. Link between the internship host company/institution and the current employer

Among the 10 respondents declared as employed, **7 did an internship**. Among these 7 graduates, **5** (**71.42%**) are employed by the company/institution where they made their internship.

2.5. EU and non-EU repartition among employed and non-employed

50% of the 2 non-EU graduates are declared as employed.
