

1. Methodology

1.1. Characteristics of graduates

The MSc in Finance and Economics – Management Risk Track counted 10 graduates in 2022.

1.2. Research protocol

At this stage, the University/Faculty do not have a deep employability survey for each Master programmes and tracks. The data of this survey have been collected with the help of the Alumni Office of the University. No questionnaire has been sent to the graduates. The data are coming from the LinkedIn social network. Each individual will be called *"alumni"*

The survey looks at the situation of graduates in week of November 7th, i.e., 2 months after the examination board.

- 1.3.1. Alumni numbers

6 graduates were found on LinkedIn, representing 60% of the graduates.

1.3.2. EU and non-EU distribution


The alumni are all EU citizens (100%).

- 2. Survey results
- 2.1. Status

100% of the alumni indicated in their profile that they are **employed**.

2.2. Distribution between the public and private sector among employed

Among the 6 alumni declared as employed, **67% are working in the private sector and 33% in the public sector**.

2.3. Geographical distribution



Among the 6 alumni declared as employed, 100% are working in Luxembourg.

2.4. Link between the internship host company/institution and the current employer

Among the 6 alumni declared as employed, **4 (67%) are employed by the company/institution where they made their internship.**

The main employers are: Deloitte, Banque de Luxembourg, European Investment Bank (EIB), Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier (CSSF)
