


1. Methodology

1.1. Characteristics of graduates

The MSc in Finance and Economics counted 17 graduates in 2022.

1.2. Investigation protocol

At this stage, the University/Faculty do not have a deep employability survey for each Master programmes and tracks. The data of this survey have been collected with the help of the Alumni Office of the University. No questionnaire has been sent to the graduates. The data are coming from the LinkedIn social network. Each individual will be called *"respondents"*

The survey looks at the situation of graduates in the November 7th, i.e., 2 months after the examination board.


1.3. Characteristics of respondents

1.3.1. "Respondents" numbers


17 graduates were found on LinkedIn, representing 100% of the graduates.

1.3.2. EU and non-EU repartition

The respondents are mainly non-European (82.35%).



82.35 % of the respondents indicated in their profile that they are **employed**. 5.88% declared as intern (profile not updated). 11.76% are still students due to the non-update or the profile or they are enrolled in another Master Programme.



2.2. Repartition between the public and private sector among employed

Among the 14 respondents declared as employed, **57.14% are working in the private sector**, **28.57% in the public sector**.

2.3. Geographic distribution

Among the 14 respondents declared as employed, **100% are working in Luxembourg**.

2.4. Link between the internship host company/institution and the current employer

Among the 14 respondents declared as employed, **13 did an internship**. Among these 13 graduates, **9 (56.25%) are employed by the company/institution where they made their internship**.

2.5. EU and non-EU repartition among employed and non-employed

100% of the 3 non-EU graduates are declared as employed.
