

Codebook

L2: The Polish-Ukrainian border:

- L1: Personal Connection
 - o **Relevance:** In this interview, the border scholar notes their personal connection to the L2 theme of this interview, showing their positionality and likely why the Polish-Ukrainian border was the focal point of this interview
- L1: Divided by borders
 - o **Relevance:** the border scholar explains how people at the Polish-Ukrainian border feel divided
- L1: the history of changing attitudes at the border
 - o **Relevance:** the border scholar talks about how attitudes between Poles and Ukrainians at the Polish-Ukrainian border changed throughout history.
- L1: The history behind the division at the border

- **Relevance:** the border scholar explains why there was division at the Polish-Ukrainian border
- L1: Refugees
 - **Relevance:** As with other interviews, the border scholar refers to the current “refugee crisis” in Europe.
- L1: Integration of Ukrainians in Poland
 - **Relevance:** This code shows how the border scholar talks about the first and second phases of integration of Ukrainians in Poland
- L1: Subjectivity of borders
 - **Relevance:** Similar to *GamingScorpion* and *Amigod*, the border scholar refers to how borders and the meaning of borders are subjective.
