Who can apply?

- Early-career researchers (ECRs) from UL who defended their doctoral thesis within the last 7 years (PhD or equivalent).
- ECRs include Postdoctoral Researchers, Research Scientists I & II, and R&D specialists in the transitional phase before being appointed to a more senior academic position. UL professors are excluded.

Why apply for the IAS Award?

The IAS Award offers more than recognition, as it empowers ECRs at the University of Luxembourg to elevate their academic journey through a unique mix of prestige, resources, and opportunities.

- 3 awards annually. Each caries an award of €1,000 as a personal recognition prize.
- The award ceremony will take place in the IAS Room and will include IAS leadership, supervisors, and distinguished guests.
