- 4. The Organizer reserves the right to amend the Lottery, or these Terms at any time without prior notice.
- 5. In the event of any dispute regarding conduct, results and all other matters relating to the Lottery, the decision of the Organizer will be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.

Section 1 – Participation Rules and Registration for the Lottery
