The University of Luxembourg is a multilingual university. Most of our programmes are bilingual (French-English or French-German), some are even trilingual or taught entirely in English.

The majority of the University of Luxembourg's student housing is located in the southern region of the country near Belval Campus. Additional halls of residence are located around Luxembourg City. Currently, the University has a total of 1,000 rooms and studio apartments available in 32 halls of residence.

#### Language Centre

The Language Centre offers general, academic and vocational courses in French, German, English and Luxembourgish for students and University staff.

#### **Sports and Well-Being**

The Office of Student Life offers a variety of sports classes and wellbeing workshops to help students improve their physical and mental well-being outside the classroom. This offer is free for all students.

#### Arts and culture

The "Espace Cultures" office runs various cultural events and activities including Open Stage formats, supporting student theatre and music groups, the University Choir. Free of charge creative workshops and free tickets to concerts and arts events are also on offer during the whole semester.

#### **Career Centre**

The University Career Centre provides counselling services including individual consultation, skills assessment sessions and workshops to assist you with your job applications. The University organises the annual Unicareers.lu recruitment fair for students and young professionals.

#### **Life on Campus**

The Office of Student Life is dedicated to helping students experience campus and daily life in Luxembourg to its fullest. It promotes and encourages student engagement and social activities in collaboration with the numerous student associations, clubs and partners.
