



This programme is designed to educate and train future professionals in inclusive finance matters. It combines traditional financial law with inclusive finance and development policy subjects. The objective is to deepen the knowledge and skills in the field of inclusive finance law and regulation with interactive courses taught by European and international academics, practitioners from international organisations and representatives of leading law and accountancy firm who promote discussions, argumentation and negotiation as an integral part of their teaching.

**OBJECTIVES:** The programme aims at ensuring awareness of the topic of law and regulation in the inclusive finance sector, enabling an exchange with regulators and financial intermediaries, and facilitating further academic and non-academic cooperation.

Moreover, participants will acquire intercultural competences, preparing them for work in international environments while also benefiting from a network of informal relations, useful for their future.

You can enrol at the University via [www.uni.lu](http://www.uni.lu). SEVE is responsible for issuing the various administrative documents required for enrolment: student card, certificates, etc.
